In addition to our guiding principles we have provided a focus, frequency, and a framework for time as well as aligned examples of homework for each grade level.

Research about reading and the impact it has on learning and school achievement is clear; students who read more, achieve higher and are more successful in school, college and careers. We promote and encourage our students to read by providing protected time in school and encouraging reading at home.
