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- Help families understand their children's learning and mental health needs
 - Push in to classrooms for social-emotional learning curriculum
 - Run counseling groups and individual counseling based on student needs
 - Coordinate counseling referrals for parents outside of the school district
 - Refer parents to community resources such as SPOA, AFY and PINS
 - Active member of the threat assessment team
 - Conduct suicide assessments - refer to Stony Brook CPEP, DASH or Mobile Crisis Unit when needed
 - Provide crisis prevention and intervention services

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- Conduct psychological assessments to identify special education needs - initial evaluations and reevaluations
 - Provide parents with information about the special education testing process
 - Discuss and suggest alternatives to special education, prior to referrals
 - Chair CSE/annual review meetings – plan appropriate individualized education programs for students with disabilities
 - Coordinate out of district placement recommendations
 - Conduct functional behavior assessments
 - Create and manage behavior plans and ongoing data collection
 - Consult with special education teachers about students with IEPs
